Access Statement

Anchor Cottage is approached from the lower end of Church Street. Luggage can be unloaded at the bottom of the road approx. 50 metres away. In less busy times it may be possible to unload outside the cottage, however this is a narrow road, and two way traffic is not an option. The road to Anchor Cottage has a slightly elevated slope. The entrance to the cottage is through a hinged gate. There is a very slight slope and one small step into the property.

The ground floor of the cottage is level, and there is good access to the kitchen area. There is one high step in the kitchen by the back door which leads out to the rear garden area. The access here is narrow with several steps which lead to the elevated seating area.

The second floor of the cottage is reached via a flight of stairs. The bedrooms and the bathroom (where the toilet is situated) have level floor areas. All door widths throughout the cottage are of standard size 710mm.

Mobile phone coverage is not always possible within the cottage, but a signal can be obtained either outside in Church Street or on Seaview Terrace, the signal is dependant on the service provider.

Car parking is provided free of charge at the main Gwynedd car park, approximately 5 minutes on foot. The car parking pass can also be used at other Gwynedd car parks with some restrictions applied.

Public transport (Arriva Bus) can be accessed from Seaview Terrace which can be reached directly down a flight of steps, or down Church Street, into New Street and onto Seaview Terrace. The train stations are at Penhelig or Aberdovey – on the outskirts of the village both approx 10 minutes on foot. A taxi service operates from Aberdyfi.
